If COVID-positive	Visitors are not allowed for COVID-19 patients and persons under investigation for possible COVID-19. - Exceptions will be made for end-of-life circumstances. - Any support person who is confirmed COVID-positive will not be allowed to enter.	
The one visitor policy means THE SAME PERSON is the visitor for the patient's entire stay.		
Emergency Room	One healthy support person (must remain with the patient, unless otherwise directed)	
OB unit (Family Birth Center)	One healthy support person (must stay in the patient's room, not allowed to wander through the hospital; can choose to leave but will not be allowed to return if leaving after 8 pm; can return at 8 am the following day)	
Surgery	Adult patients: one healthy support person Pediatric patients: two healthy support persons (must stay in the patient's room, not allowed to wander through the hospital)	
Med/Surg and ICU Staying overnight at the hospital	One healthy support person (must stay in the patient's room, not allowed to wander through the hospital; visits and leaves, does not stay the night	
	Any patient who is a child under the age of 18 must have an adult with them at all times.	
Cancer Care Center	One healthy support person, if required to assist the patient (must stay in with the patient during their appointment, not allowed to wander through the hospital)	
Outpatient Services (Imaging, Physical Therapy)	One healthy support person, if required to assist the patient Patients should come alone whenever possible, to maintain social distancing in waiting areas.	
Laboratory	One healthy support person, if required to assist the patient
